

Webinar: FEMA Guidance on Public Assistance Deadlines

Since the start of the pandemic, FEMA has provided critical assistance that has helped communities across the country save lives and protect public health and safety. As of May 4, 2022, FEMA's Public Assistance (PA) program has provided more than \$44 billion to state, local, tribal nation, and territorial (SLTT) governments and eligible private nonprofit (PNP) organizations to reimburse a wide variety of projects.

Thanks in part to FEMA assistance, the nation has made significant progress in the fight against COVID-19. In light of this progress, FEMA is establishing several deadlines for the PA program to assist SLTT governments and eligible PNPs in making their requests for PA and submitting their applications for funding for COVID-19-related work conducted under the 100% federal cost share.

FEMA will hold webinars to discuss the [Coronavirus \(COVID-19\) Pandemic: Public Assistance Programmatic Deadlines Policy](#) and answer related questions that our SLTT government partners and eligible PNPs (including hospital administrators and medical care providers) might have. Please note that these webinars are intended for the stakeholders identified, not for the general public. FEMA has specified sessions for tribal governments, hospitals, and medical care providers to ensure they receive this information directly. However, each webinar will cover the same information; choose the session most convenient for you.

Deadlines for COVID-19 Public Assistance

The [Coronavirus \(COVID-19\) Pandemic: Public Assistance Programmatic Deadlines Policy](#) will establish Public Assistance programmatic and implementation deadlines across all COVID-19 emergency and major disaster declarations and describes application of the 100% cost share through July 1, 2022, and 90% federal cost share



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effective July 2, 2022. Parties interested in applying for Public Assistance related to the COVID-19 emergency and major disaster declarations are encouraged to review and provide feedback on the policy.
